



SCENARIOS FOR CHECKING YOUR PERSPECTIVE

Scenario 1

You and your classmates are working on an entry for a science fair. Everyone has been assigned a specific task, but one team member, Alex, has been struggling to keep up with their part of the project. This is causing delays and making the group anxious about finishing on time.

Scenario 2

Scenario 3

How do you feel in this situation? What do you do next?

Scenario 4

Imagine you win \$500. What do you do with that money? Write 2-3 sentences about what you would do.

Scenario 5

Imagine you have graduated high school, and you have an awesome job lined up that starts August 1st. Then, you find out your friend is going to Europe on a trip in August and wants you to join them for two weeks.

What do you do? Write 1-2 sentences about how you feel and what you would do.

Scenario 6

You have been assigned to propose your school's next theme day. What would you suggest as a theme day? Include details about what people would wear and do on this day.
